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the national shrine in washington dc has been deeply loved blithely ignored and passionately criticized it has been praised as a dazzling jewel and dismissed as a towering byzantine beach ball in this intriguing and inventive book thomas tweed shows that the shrine is also an illuminating site from which to tell the story of twentieth century catholicism he organizes his narrative around six themes that characterize u s catholicism and he ties these themes to the shrine s material culture to images artifacts or devotional spaces thus he begins with the basilica s foundation stone weaving it into a discussion of brick and mortar catholicism the drive to build institutions to highlight the church s inclination to appeal to women he looks at fund raising for the mary memorial altar and he focuses on the filipino oratory to our lady of antipolo to illustrate the church s outreach to immigrants throughout he employs painstaking detective work to shine a light on the many facets of american catholicism reflected in the shrine

this is the story of how nazi war criminals escaped from justice at the end of the second world war by fleeing through the tyrolean alps to italian seaports and the role played by the red cross the vatican and the secret services of the major powers in smuggling them away from prosecution in europe to a new life in south america the nazi sympathies held by groups and individuals within these organizations evolved into a successful assistance network for fugitive criminals providing them not only with secret escape routes but hiding places for their loot gerald steinacher skillfully traces the complex escape stories of some of the most prominent nazi war criminals including adolf eichmann showing how they mingled and blended with thousands of technically stateless or displaced persons all flooding across the alps to italy and from there to destinations abroad the story of their escape shows clearly just how difficult the apprehending of war criminals can be as steinacher shows all the major countries in the post war world had mixed motives for their actions ranging from the shortage of trained intelligence personnel in the immediate aftermath of the war to the emerging east west confrontation after 1947 which led to many former nazis being recruited as agents turned in the cold war

covering an exhaustive range of information about the five boroughs the first edition of the encyclopedia of new york city was a success by every measure earning worldwide acclaim and several awards for reference excellence and selling out its first printing before it was officially published but much has changed since the volume first appeared in 1995 the world trade center no longer dominates the skyline a billionaire businessman has become an unlikely three term mayor and urban regeneration chelsea piers the high line dumbo williamsburg the south bronx the lower east side has become commonplace to reflect such innovation and change this definitive one volume resource on the city has been completely revised and expanded the revised edition includes 800 new entries that help complete the story of new york from air train to e zpass from september 11 to public order the new material includes broader coverage of subject areas previously underserved as well as new maps and illustrations virtually all existing entries spanning architecture politics business sports the arts and more have been updated to reflect the impact of the past two decades the more than 5 000 alphabetical entries and 700 illustrations of the second edition of the encyclopedia of new york city convey the richness and diversity of its subject in great breadth and detail and will continue to serve as an indispensable tool for everyone who has even a passing interest in the american metropolis

latin americans make up the largest new immigrant population in the united states and latino catholics are the fastest growing sector of the catholic church in america in this book historian david a badillo offers a history of latino catholicism in the united states by looking at its growth in san antonio chicago new

york and miami focusing on twentieth century latino urbanism badillo contrasts broad historic commonalities of catholic religious tradition with variations of latino ethnicity in various locales he emphasizes the contours of day to day life as well as various aspects of institutional and lived catholicism the story of catholicism goes beyond clergy and laity it entails the entire urban experience of neighborhoods downtown power seekers archdiocesan movers and shakers and a range of organizations and associations linked to parishes although parishes remain the key site for latino efforts to build individual and cultural identities badillo argues that one must consider simultaneously the triad of parish city and ethnicity to fully comprehend the influence of various latino populations on both catholicism and the urban environment in the united states by contrasting the development of three distinctive latino communities the mexican americans puerto ricans and cuban americans badillo challenges the popular concept of an overarching latino experience and offers instead an integrative approach to understanding the scope depth and complexity of the latino contribution to the character of america s urban landscapes

when the spanish civil war began in 1936 loosely affiliated groups of writers artists and other politically aware individuals emerged in new york city to give voice to anti fascist sentiment by supporting the spanish republic facing fascism new york and the spanish civil war examines the participation of new yorkers in the political struggles and armed conflict that many historians consider a critical precursor to world war ii nearly half of the 2 800 americans who volunteered to fight in the abraham lincoln brigade against generalissimo francisco franco came from the new york area fundraising propaganda and deployment for anti fascists everywhere in america were orchestrated through new york city at the same time powerful voices in new york expressed sympathy for the pro fascist side the fighting in spain brought to the surface the complex ideological and ethnic identities always present in new york politics facing fascism examines the full range of this experience including that of the new yorkers who supported franco it addresses the role of doctors nurses and social workers who left new york hospitals to provide assistance to the defenders of the spanish republic as well as those who remained active on the home front the book also describes the involvement of students in the war the key role of writers and the media and the contributions made by members of new york s art and theater communities facing fascism also serves as the catalog to an exhibition of the same name appearing at the museum of the city of new york in the spring of 2007 the book and exhibition both make use of the abraham lincoln brigade archives extensive holdings which range from historical documents to video recordings of oral histories numerous other libraries archives museums and private collectors have also been consulted to make this the most complete exhibition of its kind ever mounted the exhibition will also appear in spain
